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1. The Job of Children's Book Illustrator (Elementary, Middle/High School) 45 min. I can share how I became an children's book illustrator and how I create the cut paper illustrations. I share my early childhood drawings and how I study and research to make my picture book Sun, Moon, and Star. I would show them how to make/draw a tiger. 5 to 10 min at the end for questions.

2. Character Design Children's Books (Ages: Middle or High School) 45 min. I love to share how I create my character designs in my children's book stories. Students will enjoy the process of seeing how I create a character turn around. Students can help me do a character turn around for the Pig from the Three Little Pigs. 5 to 10 min at the end for questions.

3. Writing for Children's Books (Ages: High School and Post-secondary) 45 min. I wrote and illustrated my picture book Sun, Moon, and Star and pitched it to publishers through the slush pile. I share how I make lots of versions of the story to make it better for the reader. 5 to 10 min at the end for questions.

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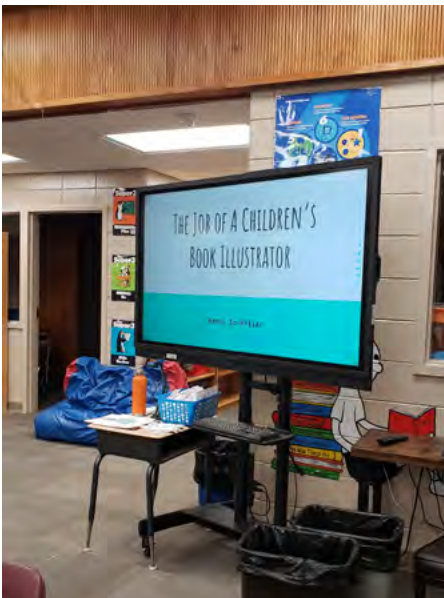
